LIFE MEMBERSHIP OF BOWLS TASMANIA

Guidelines and Criteria for nomination.

Honorary Life Membership should be awarded rarely and only where the contribution stands out from the service of others.

The nominated person should:

- Have contributed in a variety of ways to the betterment of the sport of Bowls in Tasmania, including but not limited to administration, playing, or officiating,
 - for a minimum of 10 years.
- Have either contributed directly to the work of BTAS or worked with BTAS.
- Have displayed a commitment to the stated aims and objectives of BTAS and Bowls Australia by working to a program of continuous improvement of the
 - sport in the State of Tasmania.
- Have been a unifying and positive force within the game at club, regional and state level.
- Be a person of good character and known to be honest and reliable.
- Be a financial member of BTAS.

A Nomination must be made in writing and signed by the proposer and seconder of the nomination. The nomination must be accompanied by a testament to the work of the person nominated and information should detail examples of service and contribution that fit the guidelines.

The nomination and testament should be presented to the Board of BTAS for consideration.

Life Membership should be awarded on the approval of 75% or more of the Board.
